AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTIONS BOARD CHAIRMAN, NEV MCLACHLAN
REPORT PRESENTED TO THE DIM OF THE 63rd AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL CONVENTION APRIL 2023.

As defined in the Rules for the Operation of Australian National Square Dance Conventions, the purpose of The Australian National Square Dance Convention Board, referred to as "The Board", is to oversee the operation of National Conventions. Australian National Conventions are organized and operated by a Convention committee elected in the area where the conventions are to take place. This committee's formation and operation is guided by the Board. The Board selects a successful applicant from bids submitted for a particular convention, then oversees the preparations and operation by that committee which is subsequently contracted to the Board to operate that convention. A group of interested dancers submitted a bid for Tasmania to host the 2026 National. This was considered by the Board and we will be going to Tasmania in 2026 for the 66th ANSDC. In the next few weeks a public meeting will be held in Tasmania to elect a committee and decide on dates and venue.

The Board usually meets on the day before the National Convention begins and again following the closure. At our first meeting, we sadly accepted the resignations of Richard Muir (WA) and Allen Kerr (ACT). We are sincerely grateful for the contribution from both of these members.

In total our Board is made up of fifteen Convention convenors and two associate members, as allowed in our Rules, who bring special talents and skills to our Board.

The Board Management Committee is made up of Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Executive Secretary, Treasurer, Documents Manager, myCAV Delegate, Archive Manager and a predetermined number of ordinary members (two at present). Management Committee members hold positions for three years and rotate two at a time.

At this year's meeting elections were held for Chairman and Archive Manager. Barbara Treharne was re-elected to the Archive position. After allowing the Board to contemplate what the next three years could look like with a new Chairman, I was nominated and unopposed, accepted the position.

Our Board and the square dance fraternity mourned the loss of Kit Spalding earlier this year. Kit was inducted as a Life Patron of the National Convention in 1993.

Our Board is active throughout the year, not only at our once-a-year AGM. During the past year our Board addressed issues including, but not limited to:- The Australian

Square Dance Review Special Convention Edition, Performing Rights, funds held by the Board for future National Conventions, Changes to the Manual, and future National Convention bids.

In the past, it has often been difficult to find future National Convention information online as each has its own preferred website. All future National Conventions have now been centralized onto a page dedicated to National Conventions on the squaredance.org website thanks to the co-operation of the National Society. Again, with thanks to Kevin Thomas, Ros Todd and the National Society, The Board is developing its own web presence which will contain all information and documents pertaining to The Board. Watch for more developments in the near future.

Another of our Board's responsibilities is to ensure that we have bids for future National Conventions. We acknowledge there could be possible disappointment for a group who may submit a bid only to find they are one of many and are not accepted. For this reason, and to maintain the unofficial rotation through the states and territories, we have developed an "intention to bid" list, the purpose of which is to encourage groups and states to think ahead and consider when it might be a right time to host a National in their state, particularly if there is a date of significance for the state that might have the advantage of a "piggyback" potential. Through the VSDA, Victoria has submitted an intention to bid for the 2027 National. We eagerly await further correspondence which will hopefully lead to presentation of a formal bid before our next AGM.

I'd like to express my thanks to our Board Members for their valuable and continued support and their contributions to the efforts in maintaining our goal and purpose.

In closing I'd like to repeat a comment I have made in my report at previous meetings. "The Board and other organisations who meet at your National Convention are here to serve you and provide what you want to see in those organisations. If you are not happy with your Board or Committee, or what's happening in your organization, don't complain or criticize amongst yourselves. Give your organisation feedback, go to their meetings or send your comments through proper channels. You can't change things by gossip or comments meant to undermine good intentions and promote disunity. Remember – those organisations function only because generous people volunteer".

Finally, I continue the mantra that I pledged last year for my term as Chairman – "We are Board Members, not just seats on the Board". Be safe everybod and take care.

Report for Dancers' Meeting 2023

This year has seen the association progress its SOP Manual and start to consider the changes that will be required for the Constitution and By-Laws for all three documents to function as a unit; the aim being to reduce and eliminate duplication of the association's paperwork and policies.

The ARDA conference continues each year immediately preceding the National Convention and sees more dancers attending. This conference provides education and support for cuers and dancers in a relaxed environment with both lecture and teaching sessions and two evening dances as part of the conference. This year's conference was expanded to three and a half days with three evening dances. Next year will not see a conference being held, but it will return in 2025.

It is pleasing to see all states nominating dances for both the Showcase and Intermediate sessions, with the Showcase dances being square dancer rounds. Currently, all Showcase rounds go onto the National Convention Dance List which provides the bulk of the round dances programmed during square dance sessions at the National Convention. The Teach session run by ARDA, usually as an "Intro to ..." is there to encourage square dancers to try rhythms other than Waltz and Two Step. The Experimental session and dance level has been changed to "Intermediate" and is now aimed at a lower level for dancing – the aim is to encourage more dancers to attend and dance.

Since the last convention some of the ARDA management committee met with the Board chairman to discuss possible changes to the Round Dance section of the Board's manual. This was of great insight and value for ARDA to allow it to better understand what and how the Board thinks.

The only change for the Management Committee has seen Bev McLachlan take on the role of Secretary. Thanks must go this Convention committee for allocating the Showcase session a stand-alone time slot.

President's Report to the Dancers Interest Meeting 2023

Congratulations to Kevin Thomas, Barbara Treharne, Mike Davey as our 2023 inductees to the Honour Roll. It was also pleasing to have Roslyn Burrett acknowledged at this National Convention, she would have received this award in 2020 had Covid not reared its ugly head.

The Honour Roll is to acknowledge individuals who have demonstrated an outstanding contribution to square dancing at a state and national level for a minimum of 15 years. Nominations need to be directed to our secretary, Celia Karas, six months prior to a National Convention.

At our AGM on Friday, 21 st April 2023 Barry Chandler was elected as Vice-President and Patricia Watson as Treasurer for a two year term. Our members elected to have three ordinary members to the committee. For the next year these are June Lambert (Qld), Andrew Verhoef (Vic) and David Todd (NSW). My thanks to Lorraine Keenan for her contribution, as an outgoing member of the committee, during the year.

The National Society decided in principle to support TAWS to continue using Mailchimp to distribute flyers for the next year.

Due to increasing costs of transporting merchandise to National Conventions the National Society have decided to trial online sales from the website for convention badges, traveller badges, extension bars and replacement pins. This means at the Darwin convention you will be able to order merchandise but not receive the items immediately. Convention committees will receive the year pins relevant to their convention as per the normal procedure.

The NSDSA would like to acknowledge and congratulate the longevity (greater than 50 years) of square dance groups around Australia. The plan is to have state delegates attend the club celebration and present a congratulatory certificate to the club on reaching their fiftieth and sixtieth year and also mention those clubs at the Dancers Interest Meeting at the following National Convention. I am aware that the Wild Frontier club celebrated their 50th year earlier this year.

The National website can be found at www.squaredance.au and is constantly updating its information. If you notice any errors or missing links please let us know so they can be repaired or altered. There is also a host of promotional flyers available on the website. We have a facebook page Square Dancing in Australia. The purpose of this page is to

attract new dancers to our activity. We have also began branching out to Instagram to heighten the profile of square dancing on social media.

The National Australian Square Dance Review is produced and distributed electronically four times a year with a special edition produced for National Conventions. It currently has 609 subscribers. Advertising is free of charge and the editor welcomes pictures and articles. The next Review will go out in June rather than May. Apologies to the Queensland National in 2025 as the dates listed at the back are incorrect. The convention will not be held over 18 days as listed in the Special Convention edition.

Covid initially stalled our plan to have a National Square Dance Day on the last Sunday in February, however, it requires cooperation and communication from all states and territories. We have a greater opportunity to highlight square dancing when we can talk about activities happening all over the country to media outlets.

FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
