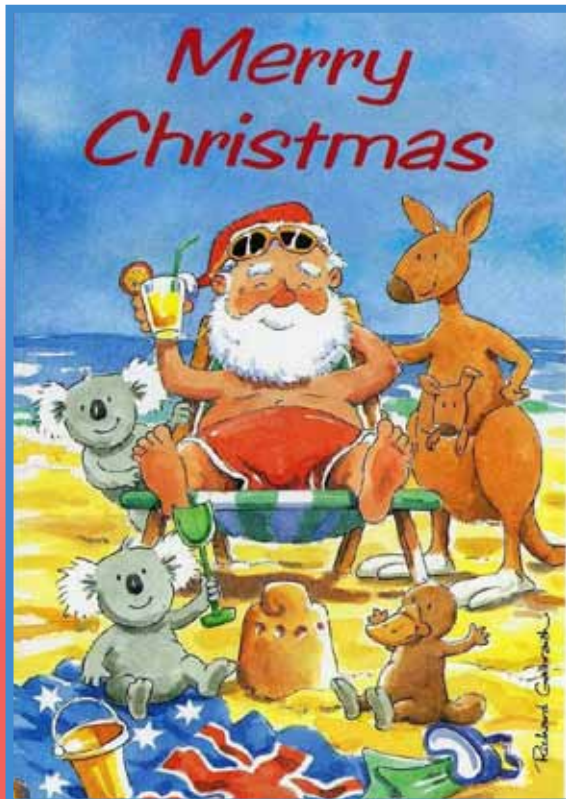

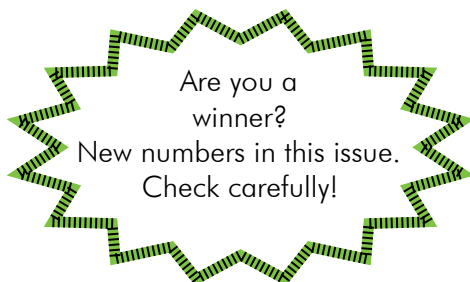

NSW President Roslyn Burrett 2007-2014



One of the first things I did after becoming President of The Square Dance Society of NSW was to visit every NSW club so members would know the face of Roslyn Burrett. This was enjoyed with my husband, Ron and some callers invited us to spend the night with them afterwards (many thanks to all those, you know who you are) but where necessary we stayed in motels. I visited most clubs yearly but made sure I did go to every one listed in the Review at least once.

In this vein, I organised a "Meet the Society" afternoon in Coffs Harbour. Clubs in the Northern NSW area came together to ask questions of the Executive who managed to join me, after which we had a soup and rolls evening meal (supplied and cooked by the Society) followed by an evening dance with every caller present (including some from the Executive) calling. I'm sure those taking part had a great time. We did this for two or three years in a row.

During the first years of my Presidency, I also got together with Alan Hansford, Gordon Hearne and Bruce Clark to update the NSW State Constitution. Many hours were spent at Bruce's home, discussing and updating then waiting for the next Annual General Meeting to have the members vote on this work then waiting again for another year to have it all passed finally. Later I also worked with Neville Jarvis and David Williams.

The 5th Saturday dances were reintroduced during my time, with most of them becoming Dinner Dances as I so enjoyed the "Cabaret" dances in my early days as a dancer.

In 2008, there were no bids for a NSW State Convention. Knowing Wellington NSW had an excellent venue (Pat Dobson had run a convention there in 1996) I decided to run one there in 2009 with the help of two local couples. While I was doing all these things, I heard on the grapevine of many dancers who had been dancing for 50 years or more. I decided they should be acknowledged for this milestone and designed and presented several "50 years of Dancing" awards, where possible at significant dances or where not possible at the recipient's club.

Over the seven years, I presented 14 certificates for 50 years, three for 60 years and also Certificate of Achievement awards to 15 clubs for running over 21 years.

Over the years at all the conventions and dances I attended, one person in particular sitting and never dancing took my notice. He was there for his wife who was dancing, so I organised a "Numb Bum Award" to Syd Thompson who was tickled pink.

During my final years it became apparent that the same people were being elected to run the dancers, callers and cuers associations so this became a discussion topic at one of our executive meetings and so the process of amalgamation began. Owen Doust took on an administrative role in developing the constitution and organising voting. David Todd and Ed Coleman assisted in this process with callers and cuers. They also offered to be President and Vice President respectively with me as Vice President and Rosalind Todd as secretary as the inaugural office bearers until the next AGM.

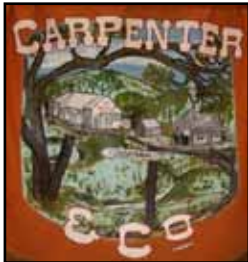

Australian National Square Dance Conventions Board Chairman's Report



After the cancellation of the 61st National in 2020 and the postponement of the 62nd in 2021, Australian square dancers again enjoyed a successful National Convention this year in Goulburn.

Congratulations to the organizing committee and thanks to all who attended. The first National after the problems caused by Covid was always going to be full of uncertainty and trepidation. Everyone understands the dilemma that most dancers faced when the time came to restart clubs, conventions and other events. We know there are still dancers who are reluctant to join in and we hope that advancements in health research, treatments and preventatives will allow us all to become more comfortable in our dance environment.

One of The Australian National Square Dance Convention Board's most important duties is to ensure the future of Nationals in Australia. We are (hopefully) locked in to visiting Adelaide next year, Darwin in 2024 and Queensland in 2025.

The decision on who will host a National is made by analysing bids submitted to The Board 3 years prior to the event. To make the bidding process easier and to ensure that bids are forthcoming, the Board keeps an "intention to bid" list. Groups within each state should be looking for possible dates when a National may be "due" in that state or when there might be a special event planned for the state that might be tied to a National in a specific year.

The "intention to bid" list contains one potential bid for Tasmania to host the 66th National in 2026, which will be the 50th Anniversary of the first Convention held in Tasmania. Registering an intention does not secure the bid but it gives other groups something to consider in their preparations.

To ensure we continue to enjoy Nationals into the future we encourage you to start discussions in your state and look at the possibility of submitting an intention to bid for a future National. Each state boasts a wealth of experience in past and serving Board members and they should be your first point of contact to plan your bid.

If you haven't already, I urge you to register for the 63rd National and join us in Adelaide in 2023.

This is your portable one-stop shop with lots of information about the Convention including the “Program at a Glance”. You'll even see all the callers and cuers as they register. Once the full program is finalised, it will miraculously show in the App, plus you'll be able to see the schedule of any caller or cuer, mark your favourites to make them stand out (with a red star next to their name) and make sure you don't miss their calls as they appear in the programme.

The easiest way for you to download the app is to go to the Convention website www.adelaide2023.com on your smartphone or tablet and touch the “Get the App” button located on the right under the banner image on every page. That will take you to the Google Play Store if you are using an android device, or to Apple's App Store if you are using an iPhone or iPad. Alternatively, you can also search for “63rd ANSDC” in either of the two stores.

The app doesn't collect any of your personally identifiable information whatsoever - no name, phone number, email address etc - nothing! So it's completely safe to download and it's free! Go ahead – it will certainly whet your appetite for what's to come!

Dancers: We're fast approaching 400 registered dancers at the time of writing. If you haven't registered yet, please remember that the price increases at the end of the year. Why not register before then if you'd like to join so many others for this great event. The committee is working really hard to make sure this Convention is truly memorable.

Accommodation: Suggestions as to where you can stay can be viewed or downloaded from our website. The Holiday 1 Tourist Park, which is close to the venue, is generously offering Convention attendees a 15% discount off their normal advertised prices if you contact them directly. It is proving a very popular choice for our dancers.

Marshalls and other Volunteers: If you are happy to spend a small amount of time helping the committee during the Convention, please let us know. In particular we're on the lookout for Marshalls to control the Round Ups during the evening sessions. As a Marshall, you also help to find dancers to fill squares, so there's sometimes the opportunity to fill a vacancy yourself if nobody else is available in time. If you can help us out during part of any evening session, please contact our secretary Jenny at secretary@adelaide2023.com. Other volunteers will also be appreciated for a variety of small jobs at various times.

Local services: Our website has information about local services such as medical and dental practices and a variety of nearby food outlets. Bordering the venue carpark is an ALDI store on Kings Road and a restaurant/pub on Martins Road, plus shopping malls are a short drive away.

First, I must apologise that I haven't been able to put in a report for a while due to family issues (which are still being resolved). However, the Board has been busy with a number of things, as follows.

2022 National Convention Outcomes

Feedback stated that a great time was had by all and that it was wonderful to be back at a national again.

Covid lockdowns gave the Board the opportunity to successfully hold more of their meetings online. It has been decided that at least some of the future National Convention Board meetings will be held online. This will also give Board members more time for other activities at conventions.

Board numbers have also been streamlined slightly, although still retain relevant positions.

Eligibility Criteria

The Board is implementing changes to the current calling eligibility criteria to make it more workable and easier to administer for the new renewal period. It ensures that callers calling at clubs which advertise dancing both Mainstream and Plus on the one night can have the hours for both recognised for eligibility. The Board propose reviewing eligibility criteria again at the Board meeting for the 2025 National Convention, after they see how the system is working now that the amnesty on eligibility hours that was put into place for the Covid pandemic period has expired (in June 2022).

Bios on the ACF website

There are a number of existing caller bios and photos on the ACF website, and the Board is working with the Webmaster and State Coordinators on the best way they can be added to and updated. The preference is to enable individuals to add or update their own - including ensuring the information is kept up to date. This should also make it easier for convention committees to get information on their registered callers.

Members will be kept updated on progress.

ACF 2025 Caller Conference

Steve Turner and his sub-committee (Howard Cockbrun, Gary Carpenter, Darren Taylor, Di Ashton and Graham Elliott) have all been busy coordinating comments and suggestions for this conference, planned in conjunction with the National Convention in Queensland in 2025. Keep a look out for more information on this exciting event as it becomes available.

ARDA President Report – 2022

This year has seen ARDA create a draft set of Standard Operating Procedures which, along with the existing Constitution and By-Laws, will oversight how ARDA is managed going into the future. The SOP Manual will require some re-writing of the Constitution and By-Laws and the aim is to have all these documents ready to deliver in draft format at next year's AGM for consideration by the members with a final vote to be taken the following year in Darwin.

Another rewarding development was the opportunity to sit down with National Board representatives to discuss the Round Dance section within the National Convention Operations Manual. A first for all of us and it proved a valuable and constructive discussion.

The National Convention Dance List (NCDL) has been updated and reviewed by members and an Auxiliary List created which can provide additional dances, if required, for the convention.

Queensland, Victoria and South Australia have all hosted round dance weekends, with interstate dancers taking the opportunity to travel and catch up with interstate colleagues. All these functions proved successful and certainly the round dancing provided at the New South Wales State Convention showed dancers still remain interested and keen. EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
